There is a wide range of activities happening in the project: building the community, developing software components, and making network of data partners, enterprises and researchers.

Although the project is open, community-based and uses open-source solutions, it still needs a common security policy to align all security activities towards common goals and give confidence to all partners that necessary security controls are in place.

University of Tartu is leading the process of putting the security policy together for this project and we are trying to follow ISO 27001 Information Security standard. While a lot has been done already, a lot of work is ahead also. Particularly, some sort of consensus should be reached in each detail that we will have in the policy. This requires several discussions to be held and many one-to-one talks to various people involved in the project.
